Beverage Program Nasher Museum Café's beverage program highlights organic wines as well as several local, North Carolina selections, all available by the glass and carafe. In addition, homemade lemonade, fresh iced tea with homegrown mint, and bottled sodas are available.

The Space The café offers one of the most unique dining settings in the region, situated under the glass and steel roof of the museum designed by renowned architect Rafael Viñoly. The café will feature an indoor dining area and outdoor seating overlooking the sculpture garden. KnollStudio tables and chairs exhibit sleek lines in stainless steel and aluminum, linking the avant-garde sculpture with the architecture. A modern "blackboard" will act as a design element, highlighting local,

seasonal items of the day. Potted herbs on tables bring the outdoors in, and remind diners of the garden-driven cuisine.
